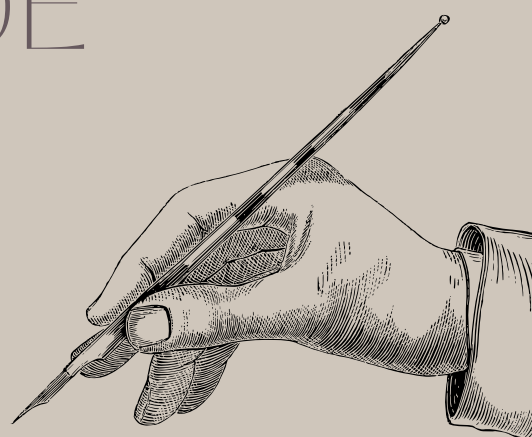

What is copyediting?

This is the process by which the Chief Copyeditor, the Editor-in-Chief, and the Copyediting Team edit your accepted work. These involve small changes such as grammar or stylistic patterns that do not affect meaning or artistic vision.

Accepted Pending Workshop

We see promise in your submission, but we have a lot of suggestions for edits. As a service to USD, we offer workshops for these submissions. Once you have workshoped the submission(s) with the prospective Genre Editor and their team, you will then have about two weeks (not including breaks or finals) to submit your edits. These will then be reviewed again and either be accepted or politely declined. Please note that 'Accepted Pending Workshop' does not guarantee publishing.

In some special cases, we offer other forms of acceptance such as Line-Editing. These are offered on a case to case basis.
